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# 2017 Dialysis Catheter Use Reduction

# Goal

A reduction in the rate of long-term catheter use among prevalent patients by at least 2 percent in dialysis facilities that have a >10% rate of long-term ( $\geq 90$  days) catheter use in prevalent patient at baseline. The baseline period shall be September of the prior calendar year, and the re-measurement period shall be the last day of the last month of the third quarter of the contract year.

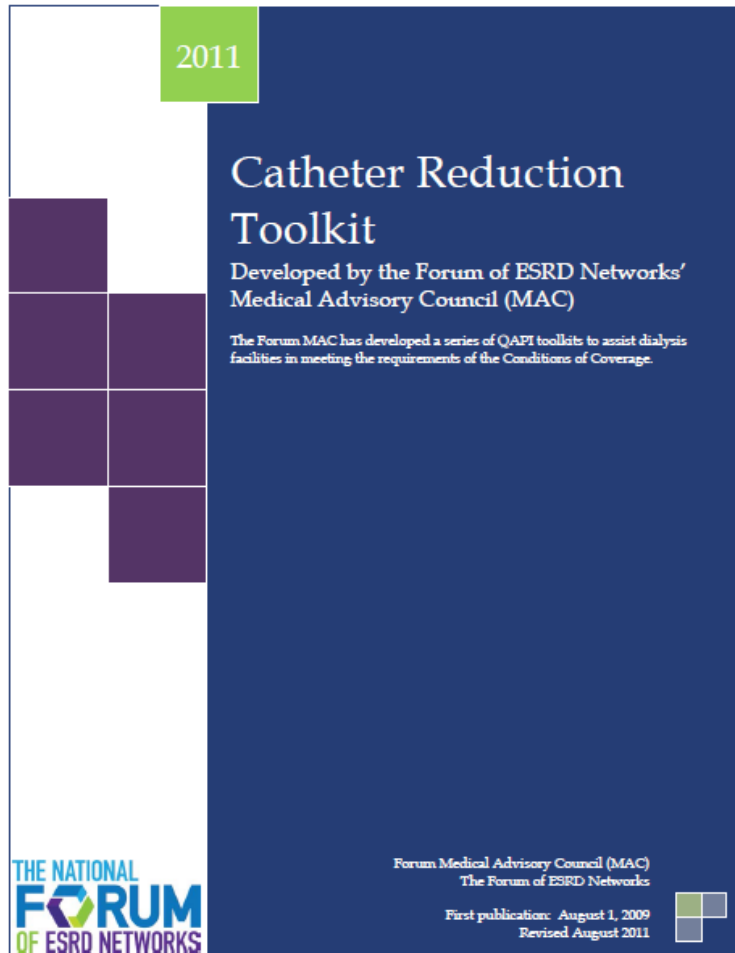



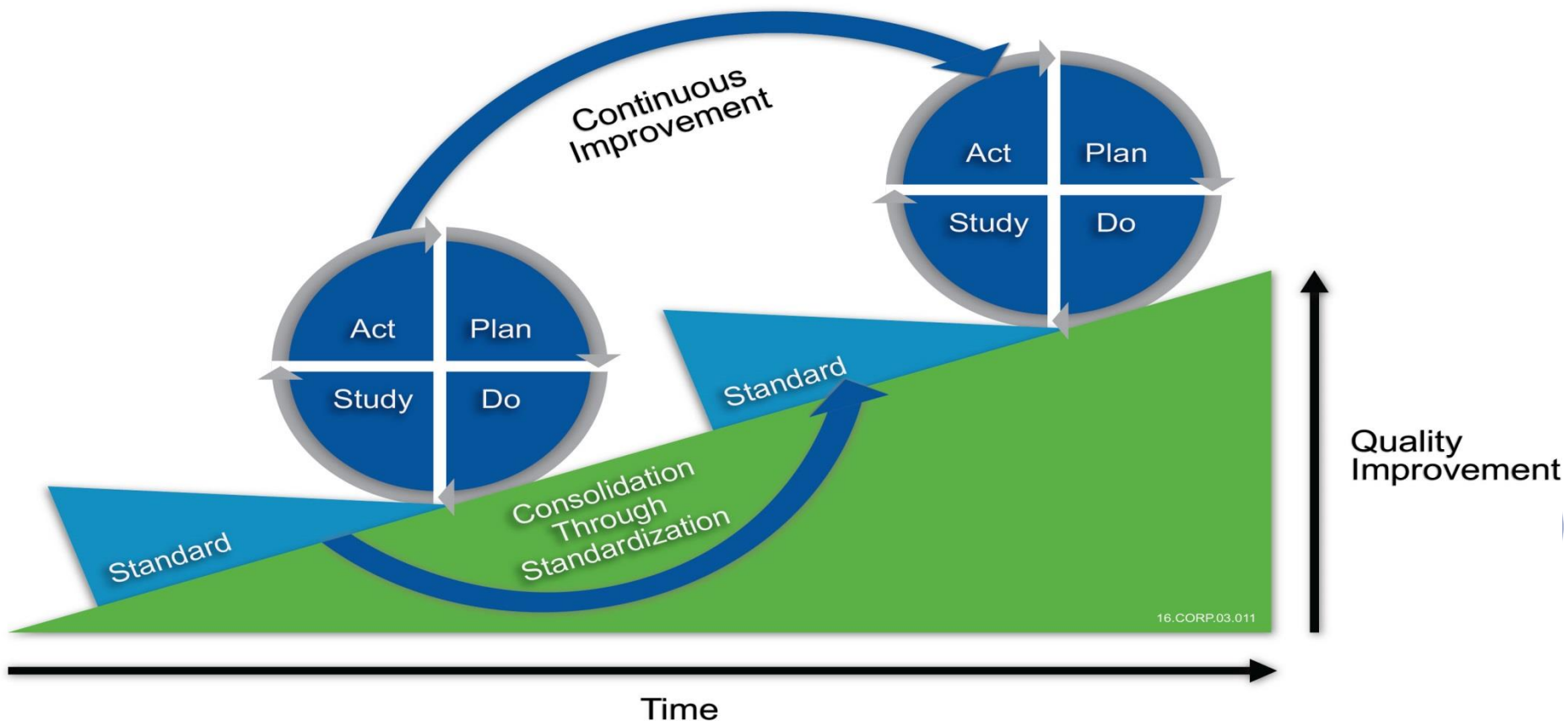
